Aggravated Robberies
3500 Blk. Moroney Drive
1000 Blk. Lakeridge Drive
Richardson, Texas

On Wednesday, August 17, 2016, and again on Saturday, August 20, 2016, two different Richardson families were the victims of aggravated robbery offenses. Armed suspects entered the victims' homes, held the victims at gun point while proceeding to search the homes for valuables. The offenders fled with personal items they were able to carry. No suspect vehicles were seen during these offenses. None of the victims were physically harmed.

The first incident occurred on Moroney Drive at approximately 4:50pm. Three black males dressed in dark clothing forced open the victim's back door and made entry. Suspect 1 was described as 30-40 years old, 5'-10" with a muscular build and 180 pounds. Suspect 2 was 20-30 years old, 5'-8" with a thin build and 120 pounds. Suspect 3 was 25-35 year old, 5'-8" medium build and 130 pounds.

The most recent offense occurred on Lakeridge Drive at approximately 4:00am. Four, what are believed to be Hispanic males around 5'-8" with medium builds, all wearing hoodies and masks, forced open the victim's back door and made entry. They spoke in both Spanish and English during the offense.
