Homicide / Aggravated Assault Richardson, TX

Today at approximately 9:00AM, Officers responded to the Kroger parking lot at 160 N. Coit Road in reference to two individuals who were stabbed by an unknown assailant. The suspect had fled the location in a victim's car before officers arrived.

Forty-two-year-old victim Arturo Negrete of Seagoville succumbed to his injuries before paramedics could get him to a medical facility. The second victim, a 52-year-old male, was transported to a local hospital by family members. The suspect, in his flight from the scene, was involved in a motor vehicle crash involving three vehicles near the Coit Road / Belt Line Road intersection in Richardson. Occupants of those vehicles were not injured. The suspect continued into Dallas where he was involved in another motor vehicle crash near Belt Line / Hillcrest. Responding Dallas PD units apprehended the fleeing suspect. It was quickly discovered that the person whom they had taken into custody was involved in the Richardson attacks.

Investigators are still working to determine a motive for the assaults. There does not appear to be any relationship between the two victims or the assailant. The suspect has been identified as 26-year-old Armando Ricardo Navarro of Garland. He is currently in custody at the Richardson City Jail. He has been charged with one count of Capital Murder and one count of Aggravated Assault.
