Officer Involved Shooting
500 Blk. Dumont Drive, Richardson, TX

On April 8, 2013, at approximately 8:30 A.M. a Richardson Police officer was working a traffic detail in the 500 Blk. of West Belt Line Road. The officer attempted to get a speeding violator to pull into a parking lot. The violator failed to follow the officer's directions and continued driving past him. The officer put out a description on the radio and another officer in the area noticed the vehicle and attempted to initiate his own traffic stop. The violator did not stop for the second officer. A third officer, who was working an unrelated traffic accident in the 500 Blk. of Dumont Drive, observed the motorist driving towards him and attempted to stop her. She ignored his commands to stop, slowed as if she might stop and then accelerated towards him making contact with him and her vehicle. The officer, in fear for his life, fired a single shot at the operator of the vehicle. The vehicle traveled a short distance before crashing into a guardrail and coming to a stop in the 600 Blk. of South Central Expressway. The driver and lone occupant was transported to Medical City hospital where she was pronounced deceased. She has been identified as 31-year-old Frisco resident, Emily J. Krumrei. At the time of the shooting, Ms. Krumrei had several outstanding warrants including two felony drug charges.

Update 4/10/13

The officer involved in the shooting was Officer Jack Kermes. He is a twenty-year veteran with the Richardson Police Department.

Initial examination by the Dallas County Medical Examiner's office revealed a single gunshot wound to the torso. The official cause of death will not be determined until toxicology results have been obtained.
